Itinerary

DAY ONE - Thursday 15/10

Arrive in Pisa first thing in the morning and explore the city, with a stop for a well deserved. Cappuccino and croissant on the way to the main square and the tower. Stop for lunch near the square and visit to the cathedral, baptistry and monumental cemetery

Sometime in the early evening, we will take the train to Florence, where we will have time for dinner, and an evening stroll on the river.

DAY TWO - Friday 16/10

A packed-fun day of discovering Florence, as sampling some of the best goodies.

Visit the Uffizi Gallery, the cathedral, Brunelleschi's dome and Giotto's tower, Bargello museu, Piazzale Michelangelo for the sunset, piazzale Michelangelo, palaces, David's copy.

Indulge in Antico Vinaio focaccia or, lampredotto, for the most adventurous, coffee/gelato break (the famous affogato, dinner at the Beppa Fioraia Osteria..

DAY THREE- Saturday 17/10

We will visit Ponte Vecchio, Palazzo Davanzati, Palazzo Strozzi and Michelangelo's bridge and walk to Palazzo Pitti, Belvedere, visit Boboli Garden and see the countryside. Then time to walk alongside the walls to Villa Bardini, Sunset in Ponte Vecchio, and an evening stroll around Santa Croce

Lunch in a typical osteria, aperitivo at the top of the Belvedere, best pizza in town followed by the most delicious ice cream.

DAY FOUR - Sunday 18/10

Breakfast and Transfer to Pisa Airport.
